Notice is hereby given that Nominations for the officer positions of President and Vice-President will be accepted at a nomination meeting held on January 8, 2026 commencing at 10 am MST at:

To be nominated a candidate must:

- 1. Have maintained a residence in a Settlement area in accordance with s. 234 of the Metis Settlements Act for at least 12 months prior to the nomination date.
- 2. Pay to the General Council by certified cheque or money order a non-refundable nomination fee of \$250 prior to election day.
- 3. Provide a long form birth certificate describing parentage prior to election day.
- Provide at the time of nomination a completed nomination form and a completed disclosure form as prescribed in Election Policy for General Council Officers Policy GC-P2022/01("Election Policy")
- 5. Not be ineligible or disqualified for office for any of the reasons set out in S. 21 of the Election Policy or for any other reason.

A nominated person who currently holds office as a Settlement Councillor, if elected to a Metis Settlements General Council Officer position, must resign his or her Councillor position.

If there are more nominees than officer positions, an election of officers by the Metis Settlements General Council will be held at MSGC offices January 22, 2026.
